## IGP Hosts Buhler-KSU Executive and Expert Milling Courses

IGP offered two courses during the month of March: Buhler-KSU Executive Milling, March 17-21, and Buhler-KSU Expert Milling, March 24-28.

The Executive Milling course offers an understanding of the underlying principles of the milling process. Participants were shown the parameters that can be influenced by raw materials or the milling system, became familiar with the challenges faced by the operating staff, and learned which critical control points to check to judge whether an operation is running well.

The Expert Milling course covered a more in-depth discussion of flow sheet diagrams, milling processes, optimum machine adjustments, and mill handling. Both courses offered an opportunity for participants

to gain hands-on experience in the Hal Ross Flour Mill.

“The overall presentation of the course was fantastic in my opinion. They followed the flow of the mill which is very interesting to me and gave me a good concept on how it goes. The general concept of the course is very good because it gives you a good overall understanding of the process and milling concepts,” said Executive Milling participant Jeff Groff.
