IGP Hosts IAOM Basic and Advanced Milling Courses


IGP hosted two, five-day courses in the month of September. The Basic Milling Principles course welcomed 13 participants, September 9–13, while the Advanced Milling course had 17 participants the week of September 16–20.

These courses provided the participants with a better understanding of the flour milling process along with techniques and tools to optimize mill efficiency. They also had the opportunity to engage in practical, hands-on learning exercises at the Hal Ross Flour Mill and KSU Milling Labs.

Course participant, David Binczewski, production and operations manager at Cairnspring Mills explained that he can now set his expectations for the mill after learning about the different quality standards and all the testing. "I even got to learn, outside of milling,

the grain procurement, which gave me a good idea as to what I am looking at in the field other than just protein and moisture." Binczewski said.

IAOM and the IGP Institute work together to offer milling courses ranging from the basic course for people new to milling, to advanced courses that provide a detailed understanding of adjustments that can be made to optimize flour production in their mills.
